Georgia Virtual School - Credit Recovery Instructions

What: Credit recovery is an opportunity for a student to retake a high school class that has been failed. This program is designed to help students graduate within 4 years of high school. The classes are offered on-line and you must have a valid email address and internet access to participate.

Credit Recovery Classes Offered: (Registration can be anytime during the year!)

Cost: No charge to students enrolled in Georgia Public Schools

Steps to Register:

- 1.** You will need your Georgia test score ID number: GTID # _____ (Get it from Mrs. Eagle or Mr. Henderson in Guidance)
- 2.** You will also need a valid email address.
- 3.** Next, just go to this website: www.gavirtualschool.org
Click on "Registration for GA DOE Credit Recovery Classes "
- 4.** Then, Click on *student only* **Create an Account (follow instructions)**
- 5.** After you create your account, an email will be sent to your email address. You will then be asked to validate your address.
- 6.** After validation, an email will be sent to Northside and we will help you complete your registration –the enrollment must be completed by a facilitator at NHS.
- 7.** Within 24-48 hours of enrolling, you should have access to the course- (select the link – "Going to Class") (*Requirement: You must have failed the class already to register.)
- 8.** Follow all instructions to complete the course work.
- 9.** If you fail a post test 3 times, you will need to request a reset through Mr. Henderson or Mrs. Eagle. If you take a class that requires an EOCT (End of Course Test) you will need to take this test later at NHS and it will be 15% of your final grade.
 - The final grade that you receive in the credit recovery class will be added to your transcript – it does not replace the previous failing grade.

Note: Students must log in with 10 days of enrollment & must login at least once in each 30 day period. Students will have a total of 22 weeks to complete a course (but completion of the course will vary based on time and effort of student.) **Good Luck! Graduate on time with your class**
